St. Timothy School Junior Beta Club Requirements

Grade Level Requirement:

- Students must be in or entering 7th or 8th grade.

Academic Requirement:

- Students must achieve an average of a 3.35 grade point average (GPA) or higher for four consecutive quarters prior to application to the St. Timothy Junior Beta Club.
- Students must maintain an average of a 3.35 GPA in order to remain an active member.
 - Students who fail to maintain an average of a 3.35 GPA can be considered for academic probation.

Service and Leadership Requirement:

- Students should actively participate in the church or other community organizations.
- Students should be involved with one extra-curricular activity.
- Students must actively participate in Beta Club events, meetings and projects.

Character Requirement:

- Student's behavior should be exemplary in the classroom, at school and while representing St. Timothy School and The St. Timothy School Junior Beta Club.
 - The number of demerits acquired will be taken into consideration for inclusion in the Beta Club.

Eligible students must complete the application using blue or black ink.

The application includes:

- Handwritten essay
- Three recommendations (one personal (friend/relative), two teachers)
- Student and parent signatures on particular forms
- Completed application form

If a student meets all of the requirements for participation and application, they are invited to be part of The St. Timothy School National Junior Beta Club.

(All submitted materials are confidential and become the property of St. Timothy School.)

A one-time membership fee of \$15.00 is required upon acceptance. Thirteen dollars is required by the National Beta Club organization for pins and membership. Two dollars will go to The St. Timothy School National Junior Beta Club for basic club supplies.
