

To prevent the spread and recurrence of communicable disease in the classroom, we require that students with the following diseases/conditions stay out of school for the specified length of time:

- CHICKEN POX: May return when all lesions are crusted (usually 5-7 days)
- CONJUNCTIVITIS (PINK EYE): May return after completing 24 hours of antibiotic as prescribed by medical professional
- HEAD LICE: May return after treatment with pediculocide shampoo and free of nits
- IMPETIGO: May return after completing 24 hours of treatment and sores beginning to heal
- MONONUCLEOSIS: Consult medical professional may return when feeling well enough
- PERTUSSIS (WHOOPING COUGH): May return after 5 days of antibiotic therapy or once symptoms have cleared
- PINWORMS: Consult medical professional may return after appropriate treatment
- RINGWORM: May return after completing 24 hours of appropriate treatment
- SCARLET FEVER: May return after completing 24 hours of antibiotic
- STREP THROAT: May return after completing 24 hours of antibiotic
