
- St. Timothy School opened its doors in 1963 to provide a quality Catholic education to this Northwest neighborhood.



- St. Timothy prides itself in preparing our students for academic success at every level of education:
- Twelve St. Timothy Alumni who attend St. Charles received recognition for their academic success this past quarter (attaining a 3.3 GPA or higher). (Eight received a 4.0 GPA and one is a current class valedictorian).

#### WHAT YOU WILL NEED

- Completed registration and application forms
- One-time \$50 enrollment fee
- Copies of Social Security card, Birth Certificate and Baptismal Certificate (if child was not baptized at St. Timothy)
- Medical forms must be completed, with required physicians' signatures, by first day of school (August 21st).
- Registration forms are also available on-line at www.sttimschool.org

#### REGISTRATION PROCESS

- Registrations of students with siblings currently enrolled in St. Timothy School must be given priority.
- Families will be taken in order of their initial registration in the parish.
- Parents of children with special needs must meet with the principal.

- Kindergarten screenings will take place Wednesday, March 13th beginning at 8:30 a.m. and ending at Noon.
- Letters will be mailed to entering students with the time of their appointment.
